His excellence in surgical technical abilities has allowed him to develop more advanced operative procedures and modify existing procedures that have advanced the field of microsurgery and reconstructive surgery as well as cosmetic surgery.

Dr. Kronowitz was a former Professor with Tenure at the world-renowned, University of Texas MD Anderson for 15 years. Dr. Kronowitz was distinguished as being the youngest

faculty member promoted to professor level. He has trained more than 250 residents and fellows in plastic surgery. In only a few short years, Dr. Kronowitz has expanded Kronowitz Plastic Surgery to 6 office locations throughout the Houston Metropolitan Region and also consults patients from throughout Texas, United States, and Worldwide. Dr. Kronowitz continues as a private practitioner to publish studies and write invited articles for peer-reviewed journals as well as lectures worldwide with plans to initiate a fellowship training program in the near future. The 3rd Edition of Dr. Kronowitz’s world-renown textbook will be published in the next several months.
